## ABOUT HEBREW FOR CREDIT

Hebrew for high school language credit, taught in the context of a Jewish school, provides our teens a unique and special opportunity to strengthen Jewish identity through language, culture, land, and peoplehood. Students learn Hebrew not only to satisfy their high school language requirement, but to further develop their Jewish identities.

Our Hebrew for Credit program has been approved by the Charlotte Mecklenburg Schools (CMS) and Union County Public Schools (UCPS) in which students will receive one year of a foreign language credit for every two years of Hebrew for Credit class. We do have several non-CMS or UCPS students who just want to learn Hebrew!

**Class meets every Wednesday from 5:00 - 7:00PM**

- From beginnings to advanced, our classes are designed to meet each student's level and pace
- Small class sizes for high teacher-to-student ratio
- Combination of project-based and self-directed learning
- This is a real class, homework will be assigned and grades will be recorded and entered into student's GPA's (UCPS students will receive a pass/fail on their report cards). Students will be asked to do independent study work to make up excessive absences
- CMS and UCPS require 135 hours of class time for one credit. In order to meet this requirement, we will have to meet for 2 hours each week. The school systems also requires that there be a final exam that is worth 20% of the final grade. In order to meet the hourly requirement, there will be some extracurricular activities scheduled
- Our classes are led by passionate Hebrew education professionals who integrate project-based learning with the Ivrit Esrai curriculum which was published by the Jewish Agency of Jerusalem specifically for teens living outside of Israel.

## HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?

Hebrew for Credit costs \$300 if also enrolling in Hebrew High. The cost of Hebrew for credit & dinner without Hebrew High is \$650 per student.
